Editor's Note

Recorded live at the Somethin' Jazz Club in New York City, the *Zack Foley Quartet* reveals new inroads in their ongoing exploration of jazz harmony and rhythm through an honest and sincere approach bordering on the meditative.

Guitarist Marvin Sewell joins the *Quartet* in their spiritual journey through pieces as diverse as *Alfie* and The Smith's *Heaven Knows I'm Miserable Now*. Sewell sheds his soulful light on the *Quartet's* original title piece, *O John the Captive*, with a deeply spiritual intro. In the *Quartet's* usual style, they dismantle tough, introspective pieces like Jeff Buckley's *Dream Brother* and overcome pop stereotypes to uncover mystical elements never before heard in Pink Floyd's *Breathe*.

In true bootleg manner, these recordings show a new approach into the sound of jazz to come.
